

APMP Capture Practitioner Certification: Overview and FAQ

What is the APMP Capture Practitioner Certification (CAP APMP), and why should you go for it?

This APMP Certification is designed to test the practical application abilities of people who are mostly involved in coordinating the pursuit of complex business-winning opportunities.

Candidates should be able to demonstrate understanding by being able to:

- apply and adapt the APMP opportunity capture planning and scheduling competencies to a given opportunity capture.
- identify, analyze and distinguish between appropriate and inappropriate application of the APMP opportunity capture planning and scheduling competencies to a given proposal/bid scenario.
- apply and adapt the APMP Opportunity capture team selection and management competencies to a given opportunity capture.
- identify, analyze and distinguish between appropriate and inappropriate application of the APMP Opportunity capture team selection and management competencies to a given proposal/bid scenario.
- apply and adapt the APMP Managing Decision Gates and Reviews competencies to a given opportunity capture scenario.
- identify, analyze and distinguish between appropriate and inappropriate application of the APMP Review Management competencies to a given opportunity capture scenario.
- apply and adapt the APMP customer focused opportunity capture skills competencies to a given opportunity capture scenario.
- identify, analyze and distinguish between appropriate and inappropriate application of the APMP Customer focused opportunity capture skills competencies to a given opportunity capture scenario.
- apply and adapt the APMP Strategy competencies to a given opportunity capture scenario.

Who is the target audience?

• This qualification is designed to test the abilities of those candidates seeking business, doing business development and pursuing new business, including capture, opportunity and business development.

What are the pre-requisites for sitting the exam?

- Have a sponsor who recommends that you should be considered for the exam.
- Have completed the Application and Sponsor Form (including the self-certification that you have studied the indicated elements of the APMP BoK).

What are the pre-reading materials?

- The basis for exam questions is the APMP BoK.
 - Please refer to the Syllabus in the <u>Practitioner Preparation Guide</u> to confirm which BoK areas are referenced.

What about CEU/CPDs?

• Members are required to earn and log 40 CEUs/CPDs every two years for the Capture Practitioner-level certification.

What is the designation?

- Successful candidates will be entitled to use the designation 'CAP APMP' (e.g. in their email signatures, on their business cards, or in their CVs).
- If you have several APMP certifications, it might look like this: 'CP CAP BW-M APMP'. (Signature certification first, Micro-Certification(s) last).

What does it cost?

What kind of exam is it?

The exam consists of 8 questions:

- 10 question items per question each worth one mark, total of 80 marks
- 2-and-a-half-hour examination (150 minutes) no additional reading time
- Pass Mark of 40+/80 to pass (50%)
- Open book, unrestricted materials

What is the duration of the exam?

- 150 minutes
- Candidates with English as a second language can request additional time when booking the exam. For further information, please visit <u>APMG Copyright, Legal & Policies</u>
- Take a Break For online exams, the exam time will be extended by 10 minutes so that you may take a break.

• To do so, click the Take a Break button. To resume the exam, click the Resume button. Be aware that the clock continues to count down during your break.

How difficult is it?

The CAP APMP qualification examines at levels 3 (apply)/ 4 (analyze). Difficulty category:

- 35-45 marks level 3*
- 35-45 marks level 4^{*}

What kind of questions are there?

What is the pass mark?

• You need 40+ out of 80 marks to pass the exam (50%).

How do candidates get their results? When I pass the exam, will I get a Certificate and a Digital Badge?

- Provisional results for the examination are fed back to candidates on-screen at the end of an online exam.
- APMG will formally process and confirm results via the Candidate Portal within 2 working days of receipt of the completed papers.
- Once the result is available via the Candidate Portal, you will be able to access your Digital Badge & Certificate.

Will the online exam be proctored through ProctorU?

• Yes

Is it available in other languages than English?

• Not currently but will be considered

What happens if I do not pass the exam?

- If you wish, you can re-sit the exam (exam fee is due again). Please note that you will be much more likely to pass following reviewing the relevant APMP BoK sections.
- There is no waiting period.
